The Humanities department is home to three of your subjects:

- History
- Geography
 - RE

You will have two lessons a week of History and Geography and one lesson a week of RE.

This is the entrance to Humanities. Upstairs is the Geography department, downstairs is History and RE is in one of these rooms or in the small block opposite.

We have a one way policy on Humanities, so you come in the front door, and exit through the one at the back of the block.



Geography

In Geography we look at the world and where we are. We learn how to use maps and other key geographical skills and will carry out some geographical fieldwork. We will learn about the physical geography of Britain and will look at topics such as mountains, rivers and coasts. You will also carry out a study into the East of England and contrast this with a study of Africa.

In History we will start by looking at life under invaders, and what it would have been like in Anglo-Saxon England. We will look at the Norman invasion and medieval times, including the role of the Church and the king. You will get to study events that would have impacted on people's lives such as the Black Death. The topics will be covered chronologically and you will be taught key skills such as analysis and how to consider the usefulness of sources.

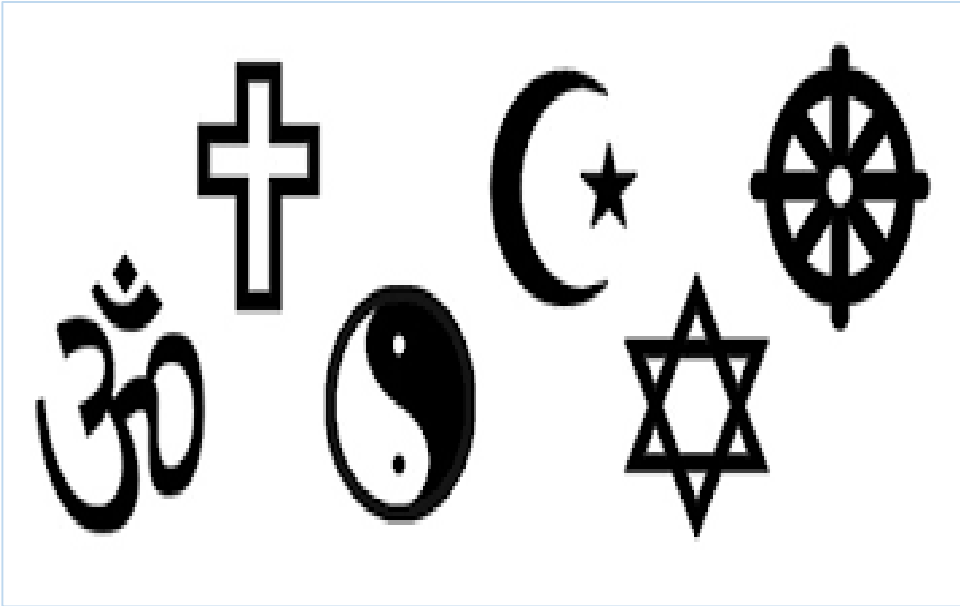
There are 5 History teachers in the department:
