To prepare you for Y12 we are setting a number of small tasks to develop and practice different skills within Hairdressing. The work should be brought to your first lesson and will be assessed by your teacher.

Task	Description	Complete 
Cutting techniques	<p>Find images of the different cutting techniques and describe the result you get from doing them.</p> <p>Present your research in an appropriate way (PowerPoint / Word) and wherever possible include photos/images to support your research.</p> <p>Extended task -Explain how to do the following cutting techniques and the angles you use to achieve the results.</p> <p>Club cutting, thinning, freehand and scissor over comb</p>	
Hair characteristics	<p>Explain what each of these hair characteristics mean:</p> <p>Hair type, Hair density, Hair elasticity, Hair porosity, Hair condition, Scalp condition and Hair growth patterns</p> <p>Present your research in an appropriate way (PowerPoint / Word) and wherever possible include photos/images to support your research.</p>	
Consultation Questions	<p>What type of questions do you think you need to ask a client who is having a blow-dry?</p> <p>Give at least 5 examples.</p>	
Styling products	<p>What result would you achieve with these products?</p> <p>Serum, Mousse, Wax, Blow-dry lotions, Moisturisers/oils, Hairsprays</p> <p>Present your research in an appropriate way (PowerPoint / Word) and wherever possible include photos/images to support your research.</p> <p>Extended tasks - Add images to show your results.</p>	
Shampooing	<p>When shampooing your own hair practice the following steps.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Damp hair 2. Apply shampoo to the hair 3. Use your fingertips to rub the shampoo into your hair 4. Wash it off by lifting the hair up. 5. Squeeze the hair then apply conditioner to your hair. 6. Massage your head slowly for a few minutes 7. Run your fingers or a comb through your hair 8. Rinse conditioner off. <p>Extended task- try this technique on friends or family, you can wash their hair over a sink or bath.</p>

Find images of the make-up techniques	Find images of the different make-up looks (Period Fantasy High Fashion Commercial Catwalk Bridal). Airbrush make-up	Explain what each of these techniques means: Even colour washing Concealing Highlighting and shading Airbrush make-up Pulsing Back bubbling Colour fading Masking Stencilling Freehand
