## Young People's Award Structure and Criteria In Curriculum Programme

The SPS Young People's Award is designed to be an introductory award, similar to preparing students for the Duke of Edinburgh Award. Students must complete three categories plus an overnight camping event.

Learn a new skill and develop it throughout the year • Spanish – learning new words. • Performance Poetry – being able to write and perform this new skill. • Samba – being able to compose and perform this style of music. • Foley Sound Effects – creating sound effects for a scene. • Drumming – using drumming to build tension in a scene. • Art – a range of new skills taught by our visiting artists. • Photography – knowing how to position objects in a photograph. Selecting interesting subjects. • DofE skills – map reading, putting up a tent, packing a bag, etc. • Archaeology – identifying different types of animals, identifying coins, etc. • Psychology – completing a range of experiments and determining the results. • STEM – completing a range of experiments and determining the results. • Maths mysteries – learning new maths skills to solve the mysteries given to you.

**Volunteering:** These activities can be in school in tutor time, and/or outside organisations. • Operation Christmas child. • Children in Need. • Helping with different charity events. • Food bank support. • Helping people, such as the elderly or disabled community • Community action and raising awareness • Coaching, teaching and leadership, such as in sports clubs and cadets • Working with the environment or animals • Opportunities within school include becoming a paired reader, helping in the library, supporting your peers in tutor time, supporting lunch time and/or after school clubs.
